Congratulations on your commitment to preventive healthcare. As your cost burden increases through higher deductibles and co-pays and greater restrictions on coverage, it is more important than ever to maintain your good health through preventive medicine. Although insurance has not historically focused on prevention, it does appear that many companies have begun reimbursing to for our services.

**At PrevaHealth, all services are paid for at the time of service.** Payment plans are available for persons who qualify. We are a Medicare ‘opt out’ facility. Thus, Medicare patients will need to pursue their secondary carrier, if any.

We are happy to provide all the information you’ll need to submit a claim to your insurance company for reimbursement. If your insurance company requires pre-certification for the services you receive, please contact your referring physician’s office for assistance.

In order to submit your claim, you will need **ICD-9 Codes**. Also known as ‘Diagnosis Codes’, these are the reasons why your doctor wants you to have a scan. This information is on the prescription from your doctor.

You will also need the **CPT Codes**, also known as ‘Procedure Codes’ to describe to the insurance company the procedures we perform. The CPT codes we use are as follows:

After your reports have been compiled, we will send them to you along with a HCFA 1500 form that your insurance company will require. Most insurance companies report that it takes 30 days to process your claim. Any reimbursement will be sent directly to you.
